Shilo Stroman wears many hats. performer, educator, composer and arranger in the Jazz, Salsa, Orchestral and Rock styles, plus the marching arts! Shilo is completely comfortable wearing many hats.

As a performer he founded “Square Peg”, a contemporary jazz quartet that performs at clubs and festivals from Denver, Colorado to Gillette, Wyoming. They just released their first CD entitled, "Searching", which contains five of Shilo's original tunes and two of his arrangements. He is also an in demand performer in the Northern Colorado region performing on drum set, vibraphone and bass guitar in a variety of musical styles. He has performed with: Art Lande, Don Aliquo, Anders Astrand, The Four Tops, Amy Grant and Trisha Yearwood to name a few. In January of 2006, he commissioned and performed the world premiere of “Sticks and Stones” variations for drum set and wind ensemble by Jim Bonney. He also performed with the Greeley Philharmonic Orchestra, the Fort Collins Symphony and the Cheyenne Symphony for ten years.

As an educator, Mr. Stroman is adjunct instructor of percussion and Jazz at Colorado State University where he teaches Jazz Combo I, Jazz pedagogy, percussion ensemble, Drum line and lessons. He is also the director of percussion at Fossil Ridge High School and Loveland High School as well as, arranger and consultant for other high schools and colleges around the nation. He has worked in the WGI activity with the Blue Knights Word Percussion Ensemble, Dakota Ridge High School and Longmont High School. Mr. Stroman is also an in demand clinician/adjudicator and has traveled to high schools, universities and festivals all over Colorado, Wyoming and Texas.

Mr. Stroman is an educational endorser for *Pro-Mark Drumsticks*, *Sabian Cymbals*, *Evans Drumheads* and *Pearl/Adams Corporation*.

Sal Martorano is retired after 31+ years of teaching experience in St. Vrain and Colorado Springs Schools.

Bands under “Mr. M’s” direction won several first place regional marching festivals as well as consistent superior ratings at numerous concert and jazz band festivals. His concert and jazz bands performed at CMEA conventions and the ASBDA National Convention. His bands have performed at Disneyland, Knott’sberry Farm, Sea World, Magic Mountain, Disney World, the U.S. Embassy in the Bahamas, Nassau Bahamas High School, and placed first at the all American Music Festival in Orlando, Florida.

Sal was Colorado state winner of the Stanbury Award for the American School Band Directors Association, The Governor’s Award for Excellence in Education, and Educator of the Year at Erie Jr./Sr. High School. Sal was the director of the A-AA All State Jazz Band, Chairman of the Colorado Bandmasters Convention, president of the Colorado Bandmasters Association, Chairman of the All State Jazz Bands, Secretary of Phi Beta Mu Honorary Band Fraternity, and president of the Colorado Italian Musicmasters’ Association. He is a member of the Colorado Music Educators Association, the Colorado Bandmasters Association, the International Association of Jazz Educators, Phi Beta Mu Honorary Band Fraternity, and Jazz 89 KUVU. He has served as a guest clinician and adjudicator throughout the state. Sal has performed with the Longmont Symphony Orchestra, Longmont Community Band, the Colorado Ambassadors of Music, the Modernaires Swing Band, and is presently co-leader and performing with Swing Shift Jazz Combo.
