Sal Martorano earned a bachelor's degree in music education from Adams State University and a master's degree in computers in education from Lesley College. He has also completed additional graduate study hours in music at the University of Northern Colorado, the University of Colorado, and Western State College.

Sal Martorano taught in the public and private schools for over 35 years. Bands under his direction consistently received superior ratings and placed first at many state festivals. He received the Governor's Award for Excellence in Education, the American School Band Directors Association Stansbury Award, Erie High School's Educator of the Year, the Colorado Phi Beta Mu Outstanding Bandmaster Award, the St. Vrain Gold Star Award, and was inducted into the Colorado Bandmaster's Association Hall of Fame.

He was selected as director of the State Jazz Band, chairman of the All State Jazz Band Committee, and president of the Colorado Bandmasters Association. Sal has performed with the Longmont Symphony Orchestra, Longmont Community Band, the Colorado Ambassadors of Music, the Modernaires Swing Band, and presently leads and performs with Swing Shift Jazz Combo.

A man of many passions, Erik Applegate is a bassist, composer, and songwriter, and Professor of Jazz Studies at the University of Northern Colorado. His latest album, *Two's Company*, was featured in *Jazziz Magazine*. Current projects include touring and recording with the Dana Landry Quartet and Born To Wander (an indie jazz & Americana trio), creating a jazz "concept" album (theme and story still in development), and contributing to an upcoming Julia Dollison big band project.

Called "a top-notch acoustic bass performer" by *JazzReview.com*, Applegate has performed with the Bob Mintzer Big Band, Nnenna Freelon, Milt Jackson, Louis Hayes, Jeff Coffin, Mulgrew Miller, Eddie Daniels, Dick Oatts, James Williams, Harold Mabern, Ed Thigpen, and others, and has appeared throughout the U.S. and in Europe, Australia, and China.

Red Skies, Applegate's debut CD, reached #2 on the *Roots Music Report*, and he is heard on albums including Steve Owen's *Stand Up Eight*, Dana Landry's Grammy-nominated *Journey Home*, and 7ON7's *Back When It Was Fun*.

He holds an Undergraduate degree in Music Education from the University of Northern Colorado and a Master's Degree in Conducting from The American Band College at Southern Oregon University. He was named Campus Middle School Teacher of the Year and has received the Phi Beta Mu Outstanding Young Band Director Award. He has been a regular guest conductor at the Lebanese Band Association for Music summer camp in Beirut, Lebanon. Mr. Wynes grew up in southwest Colorado and graduated from Montezuma-Cortez High School. He now lives in the Denver with his wife Sara, son Henry, and a brand-new baby Charlotte.

Orlando Otis

Mr. Otis began his teaching career at Gateway HS where he was the Director of Bands and Dept. Chair for 3 years. Orlando was awarded the outstanding 1st year teacher award as well as 1 of the 3 outstanding teachers in the building award 2 out of 3 years. Orlando was also the director of Bands / Orchestra and Dept. Chair at the Denver School of the Arts in Denver Public Schools. The DSA music programs under his direction received numerous awards and recognitions at local, regional and national festivals, competitions and performances. From 1991-1997 he was also the director of the award-winning Denver City Wide Marching Band. The band marched at 6 National Bowl Games, performed at the G8 Summit as a guest of Denver Mayor Wellington Web and President Bill Clinton and the band 200 members strong, marched at the 1997 Tournament of Roses Parade in Pasadena, CA. During his 11 years as Band Director and Performing Arts Dept. Chair, his Chaparral music ensembles performed at CMEA, the Reno International Jazz Festival and many other events. His jazz bands have been recognized as one of the best in the state (performing at CMEA) and his wind ensembles consistently receive superior and excellent ratings at state and national festivals. Mr. Otis founded the CHS: "High Plains" Jazz Festival, which ran for 12 years. The Legend Jazz Band has also performed at CMEA and the Reno International Jazz Festival.

Orlando received his BA in Music Education from Louisiana Tech University and plays trumpet, piano and composes. He has served on numerous district and building committees throughout his career and is active as a clinician and adjudicator throughout the state. Mr. Otis lists his Mother, Father, Grand Father, Dr. Barbara Batey, Dr. Mary Gill and Steve Gonzales as influential figures in his life.
